



LIBRARY RECEIVES TWO GRANTS

The Library has received a \$10,000 grant from the Praxair Foundation’s “Library Links” program which assists public libraries in upgrading their technology, acquiring new materials or initiating innovative programs. The funds will be used to support in part the library’s continuing project to digitize microfilmed copies of the local newspaper, *The Nazareth Item*. The newspaper was published between 1891 and 1975. The digitized copy can be searched from the library webpage at www.nazarethlibrary.org.

The Library has also received a \$13,400 federal grant from the Library Services and Technology Act program which will be used to establish a staff computer lab for technology instruction.
